Footnotes

HOWE GREAT set the pace off the rail, opened a clear lead in midstretch, then was fully extended to hold sway. WHICH MARKET rated off the pace, eased out in the stretch and rallied for the place. ALL FOR THE TRIP unhurried early, altered course to the outside for room in the stretch and finished willingly for the show. ARGENTINE TANGO rated off the pace, advanced five wide around the far turn to reach contention but had no further response. TWO MONTHS RENT stalked the pace, then steadied in behind a wall of horses at the eighth pole and failed to recover. LEATHERWOOD (IRE) stalked the pace four wide into the stretch and tired. MOOR OF VENICE reserved off the pace, raced four wide around the far turn, then faltered. BENNYFAX raced with the pace three wide into the stretch and gave way. DONT MESWIT GOLDIE allowed to settle, swung wide for the stretch run and never threatened. SHADOW RUNNER tracked the pace, made a run along the rail down the backstretch to try HOWE GREAT into the far turn, then was fading when he clipped heels with WHICH MARKET leaving the far turn. REV IT UP stalked the pace for a half mile and dropped back. THE RIDER OF SHADOW RUNNER LODGED AN OBJECTION AGAINST THE RIDER OF WHICH MARKET FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE LEAVING THE FAR TURN. THE CLAIM OF FOUL WAS NOT ALLOWED.
