**Footnotes**

ADDING ALPHA chased the pace along the inside, angled out for the stretch run, then rallied to be up in the final strides. MORE THAN SPEED showed speed along the rail to deep stretch, then couldn't resist the winner in closing yards. BREW BLESSINGS chased the pace into the stretch but didn't do enough late. MISSPARTYPANTS well placed in behind rivals, gained ground late along the inside without threatening the top ones. DADDY'S KISS unhurried early, swung out for the stretch run and closed with a belated rally. SUIVEZ MOI chased the leaders three wide around the turn, then gave way. MILLENNIUM STAR rated off the pace, saved ground the turn and improved her position. MALIBU RED was caught in tight soon after the start and failed to menace. ELLA MARIE off slowly, was no factor while racing three wide. SWEET GRACIE was outrun after being caught in tight at the start. BATUTA broke slowly, was saving ground when steadied on the turn and never threatened.
