SUESTEPS was allowed to settle in near the back of rivals, steadily began to advance position, forced to check heading into the turn, continued to dig in along outside, drifted out slightly in the late stretch and prevailed under right handed urging. BAHIA DE ORO stalked the early front runners, advanced position along the outside, took command entering the turn, was challenged by SUESTEPS in the late drive and could not hold on in the late drive. INDYGO FASHION saved ground racing along the inside, continued inside bid in the stretch and steadily gained ground. HOOCHIE KOO stalked the early pacesetters, raced two wide in the turn and improved position in the stretch. MY WONDER BABY moved out midway in the final turn causing KIASU to fall. STARSHIP CHLOE raced in the back of rivals and improved position. PURE ANTICIPATION raced evenly and failed to rally. GET THE PICTURE failed to be a threat. DOUBLE THE LEAD lacked response throughout. WEST SIDE GLORY showed early speed, took command and began to falter heading into the turn. MAGIC MELISSA made a brief bid in the early going and steadily faded. KIASU dropping back midway in the final turn, was bothered by MY WONDER BOY and fell. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS INQUIRY, MY WONDER BABY WAS DQD FROM 5TH AND PLACED ELEVENTH FOR INTERFERENCE TO KIASU ON THE FINAL TURN.
