DUDEMAN stalked the pacesetter in the clear and off the inside two wide, moved on that one entering the stretch and quickly drew clear under a drive. H TOWN BROWN tracked the pace from inside, was forced to wait behind a wall of horses through the second half of the turn, split foes at the three sixteenths pole but at this point the eventual winner had already opened a clear advantage, held place through the lane. MANDATARIO was well placed off the inside stalking the top flight, got through between runners three wide into the lane to capture show honors. COACH INGE bobbled a few strides out of the gate then veered out a path and bumped the outside rival, was angled widest of all heading into the turn, raced six wide from the three eighths, had no closing kick. WORLD CHANGER raced four wide throughout, was asked to pick it up at the quarter pole but came up empty. ROMPIN REID was bumped shortly after the start and relegated toward the rear, raced inside throughout. HOLLYWOOD IDOL raced between runners toward the rear down the backstretch, had no late bid. TEQUESTA STORM stumbled at the start but quickly recovered and was rushed to set the pace inside, gave way in the lane. EMPOWER raced four wide in a stalking position, was hard ridden heading into the turn, continued to be urged racing five wide on the turn, weakened.
