Footnotes

THUNDER ON TAP was reserved just off the leaders from the inside, angled out with a furlong to run, reached the fore nearing the sixteenth pole and held off the closing SHAIKHA to prevail. SHAIKHA was allowed to settle early, moved far outside through the second turn, responded to aggressive urging, could not reach the winner late but finished with good energy. ULTIMATE SPEED chased the pace of DIXIEDOODLEDANDY from the outside, moved up to engage that rival nearing the quarter, vied into deep stretch but could not resist the closers late. DIXIEDOODLEDANDY (IRE) sprinted clear at once, saved ground while setting the pace, responded when challenged by ULTIMATE SPEED nearing the quarter, vied with that foe and gave way late. ACQUISITION was void of early speed, raced wide through the second turn and found her best stride late. BET ON KITTEN raced off the pacesetters from between foes, angled inside through the final sixteenth, steadied late and lost chance for better placing. ALGUNA chased the leaders from the outside for three-quarters and gave way. UNION SQUARE showed no early speed, saved ground through the second turn, lacked racing room nearing the five-sixteenths pole and failed to rally thereafter. FOREVER FOR ALWAYS was forwardly placed early, raced outside through the second turn and gradually weakened.
