Footnotes

HARRY'S HOLIDAY was never far back while racing along the inside, angled out approaching the stretch, reached the fore with a sixteenth to run and drew off with complete authority. KITCHEN POLICE stalked the leaders from the outside, moved up to offer a bid nearing the three-sixteenths pole, gained a slight edge but could not match strides with the winner in the drive. SWEEPIN ROMANCE raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn and finished with a steady rally. LORJIM was off a step slow, raced off the leaders from the inside, angled out nearing the five-sixteenths pole, angled back inside in mid-stretch and finished evenly late. HIGH ROLL showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention. RIGHT ON COURSE dueled for the lead from the inside and weakened after going a half. YOU LIE disputed the pace from the outside for a half and weakened.
