HUDSON MIRACLE broke sharply then was allowed to settle, moved up from between foes to reach contention nearing the quarter, reached the fore nearing the three-sixteenths pole and drew off as a handy winner. ROMAN'S AVENUE sprinted clear soon after the start, raced off the rail while setting the pace, yielded to the winner in the drive but was clearly second best. YANKEE KITTEN raced unhurried early, angled inside nearing the quarter and finished with good energy. LEVY raced off the pacesetters from the inside, angled out in mid-stretch and finished evenly. HAPPY RUNNER was away alertly to race just off the pacesetters from the inside, dropped back nearing the half, angled out into the stretch and did not threaten. SATURDAY'S FOR FUN was void of early speed, raced wide through the second turn and did not menace. CHEPSTOW was never far back, raced wide through the second turn and weakened in the drive. SIR LESLIE raced off the leaders early, was carried far outside through the second turn and was not a factor. CASHLEIGH raced off the leaders from between rivals and gradually weakened. TAKE A HINT chased the leaders from the outside, drifted out nearing the quarter while weakening and continued to retreat.
