**Footnotes**

HIGH WIRE KITTEN stalked the two pacesetters three wide and in the clear, was put to a drive and edged closer through the lane, gamely got up in the final strides to win the head bob. ALL STAR KITTEN attended an easy pace two wide, inched away from the pacesetter through upper stretch, was out-nodded to just miss. AMELIATHEAVIATOR saved ground racing inside, had to wait briefly behind runners in the latter portion of the far turn, shifted out through upper stretch and having obtained clear running room closed fast but belatedly. WHISPERING set the pace inside racing under moderate pressure, yielded late. MARIE ANTOINETTE was just a bit slow into stride at the start, edged closer down the backstretch, launched a four wide bid in earnest at about the five sixteenths pole, drew to contention heading into the stretch but flattened out. TURTLE RIVER was close early, raced three wide on both turns, weakened. GINA'S KITTEN never threatened. SALONSUN (GER) dropped in to the rail for the first turn while trailing, shifted out to make a three or four wide middle move heading into the far turn but couldn't sustain that effort and weakened thereafter. ANY DAY NOW brushed the gate at the start, never factored. FLOWER MARKET saved ground, retreated along the inside.
