QUEEN FOR LIFE reserved off the pace, angled out for the stretch run, then rallied outside CORBINS VILLAGE to be just up at the wire. CORBINS VILLAGE rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn, rallied to gain the lead in the stretch, then just failed to last. DEVERELL stalked the pace, made a run to reach even terms for command in early stretch but was outfinished. SMOKIN ALI allowed to settle, rallied four wide around the far turn to

loom a threat racing into the stretch, then gave way. PINAFRA unhurried after being bumped and steadied at the start, advanced to reach contention on the far turn but couldn't gain late. HAPPY HANNAH raced three wide and failed to menace. FANDANGO STEPS was no factor after being knocked into PINAFRA at the start. PATIENT APPROVAL tracked the pace, rallied to take over on the far turn, made the pace into the stretch, then tired. EXCHANGING SMILES stalked the pace to nearing the stretch and faltered. LADY NIIGON was outrun after breaking poorly. TOCCATINA showed little. AZISA bumped hard with FANDANGO STEPS at the start, moved up quickly to gain the lead racing around the first turn, made the pace into the far turn, then faded.
