Footnotes

BRISTOL DANCER tracked the early pacesetter, made a two wide bid heading into the turn, edged up to challenge MACARTHUR CAUSEWAY at the top of the lane, vied for the lead, edged by rival midstretch and held clear late. MACARTHUR CAUSEWAY took command in the opening quarter, continued the clear leader, challenged by BRISTOL DANCER at the top of the lane, dueled for the late lead, continued to dig in but could not get by rival in late drive. STRONG FIRE stalked the early front runners, made a bid along the inside in the turn and continued a steady two wide bid in the stretch. BOB CAN'T JUMP unhurried in the early going and made up ground in the stretch. HONOR'S GOLD raced up close and tracked the early leader, steadily weakened along the inside heading into the turn. SLAMMIN' SLEW raced four wide at the top of the lane and failed to be a threat in the late drive. LANCE'S SONG reserved in the early going and passed tiring rivals in the stretch. ACT OF DEFIANCE raced five wide in the turn and was no threat in the stretch. CONGRATS CRIMINAL broke outward at the start and failed to be a menace. BEHIND THE PEW raced evenly near the back of rivals and was never a factor. SAGAMORE raced within contention in the opening quarter and showed little after.
