SCORCHER was caught in early traffic, stalked the pace into the stretch, eased out, rallied to engage GOOFY FOOT inside the eighth pole, then wore that

rival down to be just up at the wire. GOOFY FOOT rank under restraint in the early going, angled out and rallied four wide around the far turn to gain the lead in the stretch, then responded when challenged by SCORCHER inside the eighth pole and just failed to last. MAGIC MIDDLETON allowed to settle, raced five wide around the far turn and rallied for the show. DUPES unhurried early, advanced to loom a threat in the stretch but didn't do enough late. TORMENTO pressed the pace between horses, eased to the inside when ADVANCEANDRETREAT dropped back, gained the advantage from KING KEENE on the far turn, made the pace into the stretch, then gave way and finished on even terms with BACK IN FLORIDA. The latter, stalked the pace three wide into the stretch and tired. BIG HEAT failed to menace. CRIME FAMILY was not a factor. KING KEENE raced with the early pace along the outside, took over racing down the backstretch, set the pace under pressure into the far turn and faltered. JONATHAN C allowed to settle, made a run four wide to loom a threat on the far turn, then faded. MARKET STRIKE was through after a half mile. ADVANCEANDRETREAT pressed the pace along the rail to nearing the far turn, then stopped.
