**Footnotes**

ARGENTINE TANGO unhurried early, angled out for the stretch run, then drifted in impeding SATURDAY LAUNCH while moving to gain the lead at the sixteenth pole and drew clear. EL ROMANO reserved along the inside into the stretch, angled wide for racing room and rallied to be up for the place. LIQUIDITY TRAP well placed in behind the leaders, rallied four wide around the far turn to reach near even terms for command inside the eighth pole but was outfinished. SATURDAY LAUNCH rated off the pace, rallied four wide into the stretch, then checked to avoid ARGENTINE TANGO inside the eighth pole and failed to recover. IMPERIAL ROBYN chased the pace, moved to take over on the far turn, made the pace to the sixteenth pole, then gave way. GAELICO stalked the pace into the stretch, then steadied in traffic at the sixteenth pole and weakened. SARAVA'S DANCER chased the pace three wide into the stretch, then steadied from tight quarters inside the eighth pole and tired. CAPTAIN WEBB allowed to settle, advanced off the rail to reach contention in the stretch, then steadied from close quarters nearing the sixteenth pole and faltered. CAPTAIN BEN set the pace along the rail into the far turn and faded. FOLLOWING AN OBJECTION BY THE RIDER OF SATURDAY LAUNCH, ARGENTINE TANGO WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED FOURTH FOR INTERFERENCE TO THAT RIVAL IN THE STRETCH.
