Footnotes

RICOCHET COURT broke well, allowed the pace to go early, stalked in the run up the backstretch inside, steered in slightly then launched a rail bid inside the two leaders inside the furlong marker, proved best. EL TUSCANO washy prior to loading into the gate, got clear to set the pace before a quarter, showed the way into the lane, came out, bumped with REY ROCKET midstretch, could not contain the winner. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY REGARDING THE STRETCH RUN, EL TUSCANO WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM SECOND AND PLACED THIRD. REY ROCKET forwardly placed, ranged up outside EL TUSCANO to challenge that rival in the second turn, bumped by that same foe when straightened for home, also failed to contain the winner. MR. PUMPERMICHAEL raced in mid pack early in company, moved closer before a half, got closest turning for home, flattened out a bit late. TANGO KID off the pace and the inside, raced three wide and in some traffic second turn, brushed with BIG BOSS BABY in upper stretch, went evenly in the drive when clear. EDSON'S RIDGE shuffled back at the start, trailed early, made a late run through traffic. HOW ABOUT PEACE lacked speed, was four wide when well off the pace second turn, improved position down the lane while not posing a serious threat. BIG BOSS BABY well back off the pace, was four out to five wide in the second turn when moving a bit closer, brushed with TANGO KID upper stretch, flat finish. WARDROOM was never a menace while racing of the inside. MARCHWOOD (GB) showed little while always outrun. SLEEPING BULL fractious prior to the start, last away, closer while four wide into the far turn, gave way from between foes soon after. SCANDALO well off the pace, enjoyed a good trip along the inside through the second turn, failed to respond in the drive.
