Footnotes

MOVE OVER closest to the early leader, asked for run into the turn after falling back a bit, saved ground through the bend, challenged along the inside entering the stretch, drew clear. TOWNCAT lacked early foot, came five wide out of the turn, roused while widest for the drive, finished willingly to be in time for the place. STARSHIP TITAN off the pace and the rail, moved out a bit to be four wide turning into the lane, lugged in, closest to the winner late, could do little with that rival to the wire, caught in the final strides for the place. APOLLO SKY fell back along the inside into the turn, continued inside, moved out to be three wide exiting the bend, lodged a mild rally to miss the show. PLENTY OF POPP ducked to the outside start, raced four wide into and through the turn, lacked a closing response. ROCK STAR MIA within striking distance while racing well off the rail, weakened in the drive. SPIVEY trailed most of the way while never a threat. MY DADDY'S DOLLARS asked to clear soon after the start, maintained daylight into the turn, allowed the winner the rail entering the stretch, gave way soon after when headed.
