GAME FAIR unhurried for a mile, moved closer off the inside late in the final turn, challenged on the outside when straightened for home, wore down the two leaders under steady handling. JANICELLAINE (IRE) within striking distance, moved to challenge in the third turn, vied between foes upper straight, could not match strides with the winner late, proved game for the place. CIAO BELLA forwardly placed from the start, encountered some early traffic entering the front stretch the first time, continued to prompt the issue in hand, took over and gained the advantage in the third turn, long drive, outfinished for the place. GLAMOUR N GLORY well back for over eight furlongs, advanced three wide into the stretch, angled in sharply toward the rail nearing the furlong grounds, finished up evenly. HAVANT (GB) slow to settle while advancing to the front well wide in the first turn, cleared to the inside in the second bend, vied through the final turn, weakened when the real running started in upper straight. INDY ANNESTESIA showed the way early, headed and fell back a bit, began a steady retreat after five furlongs.
