KITON stalked the vanguard in the early going, willingly advanced three wide heading into the turn, wrested command, drew clear in upper stretch, held sway. MAJESTIC HOLLYWOOD chased inside early, shifted out on the turn, was asked for run at the quarter pole, four wide entering the lane, improved position. TIME THIEF TOO dueled inside through the opening three sixteenths, dropped back along the rail, angled outside foes in upper stretch and came again to capture show. RONTOS' CODE set the pace off the rail, weakened. THE CULCHIE was close early racing four wide, had no late bid. BRIGHT GUY stalked between runners, faltered, faded. MONTESARCHIO raced off the inside, was asked to pick it up at the three eighths and had no response. PUT IT FORWARD brushed the gate, hesitated a bit at the start, checked after leaving the gate and then was slow into stride, showed some late interest in deep stretch.
