NEVADA KID broke alertly, slowly got clear and to the inside the opening quarter, showed the way through the turn while pressured, suddenly well clear when straightened for home, not threatened to the wire while being steadily kept to task. FORT BOONESBOROUGH bobbed slightly at the start, raced back, two path through the turn, knifed out between foes under clever handling turning for home, finished willingly for the place, no match for the winner. PORT CONWAY flashed early foot inside, fell back a bit off the pace through the turn, two path into the lane, went evenly down the stretch, caught late for the place. POPPA LOVES MAMBO pressured the pace off the inside for five furlongs, had little left for the drive. SMALL TOKEN lacked early foot, continued back into the stretch, picked off a couple of tiring foes while never a threat. TOE TAPPIN TEDDY off the early pace, moved out, advanced into contention on the outside midway on the turn, gave way turning for home. DAVINS TICKET was never a factor.
