QUEEN OF KING ST sprinted to a clear lead along the inside, made the pace into the stretch, then responded when INVISIBLE VISION made a run at the him in the stretch and prevailed in a game effort. LEMONS TO LEMONADE tracked the pace three wide, advanced to loom a threat in the stretch but couldn't get to the winner while up for the place. INVISIBLE VISION tracked the pace off the rail, made a run to reach the winner in midstretch, then

weakened. SMART FARMING steadied to avoid RESOUNDINGLY on the first turn, saved ground and finished willingly while unable to catch the top ones. ZEENUT outrun after being jammed back at the start, closed with a belated rally. DESERT WITCH reserved off the pace, came out impeding RESOUNDINGLY on the first turn, then gained some ground without threatening. BAY POINT COUNTESS unhurried early, saved ground while advancing around the far turn but had no late response. HIGH ON KITTEN allowed to settle, swung wide for the stretch run and gained ground late. SUCH A SWEET GIRL steadied on the first turn and failed to menace. RESOUNDINGLY was no factor after clipping heels with DESERT WITCH on the first turn. SIN FRENO was outrun after being steadied when she bumped with ZEENUT at the start. STARSHIP BALLERINA rated off pace after being steadied when she bumped with ZEENUT at the start, advanced four wide around the far turn to reach contention, then faded. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS INQUIRY, DESERT WITCH WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED TENTH FOR INTERFERENCE TO RESOUNDINGLY ON THE FIRST TURN.
