Footnotes

INDIANO was allowed to settle behind front runners in the opening quarter, steadily began to advance position heading into the turn, raced three wide at the top of the lane, edged up to leaders midstretch, dug in late and kicked clear. OFF THE JAK stumbled slight away from the gate, quickly recovered, raced up close and tracked the early leader, edged up to the lead at the top of the lane, vied with rivals in the stretch and could not hold off INDIANO in late strides. ACTION ANDY raced up close and stalked the top two leaders, edged up to the lead at the top of the lane, continued to match strides in the stretch and slightly weakened in the late drive. BULL DOZER reserved in the early going, raced five wide at the top of the lane and slightly gained position in the stretch. DREAMING OF NENO took command in opening stages, continued to be the leader by a slight margin at the half and began to falter thereafter.
