BROTHER PAT stalked the early front runners along the inside in early stages, angled out three wide and advanced position, raced four deep in the turn, continued three wide in the stretch and kicked clear under driving finish. SCREENPLAY settled along the inside in the early stages, began to advance position between rivals heading into the turn, urged between in the late drive and lacked final kick to prevail. NINEINTHENINE stalked the early front runners, steadily advanced position three wide nearing the far turn and continued a steady bid three to four wide in the stretch. TARGET SIGHTED tracked the early leader, slightly dropped back after a half, lacked racing room in the late stretch, urged between rivals and slightly gained ground late. CLEMENT ROCK reserved in the early stages, steadily advanced position along the outside, raced five wide at the top of the lane and slightly improved position. HOLY SMOKE tracked the early pacesetter, continued behind the leader going into the turn and steadily weakened in the stretch. DIAMONSDIPLOMAT took command early, continued to set the pace along inside, challenged by rivals going into the far turn and had nothing left late. DOMINANT JEANNES raced up close tracking the early leaders, began to weaken going into the far turn. LET'S DO IT settled in near the back of rivals and lacked late response. FLATTER THIS raced near the back of rivals near the inside and failed to make a impact.
