### Footnotes

SUCCESSFUL SONG pressed the pace in the opening quarter, allowed to settle in and track the leader, began to advance position two wide heading into the far turn, asked for response at the top of the lane, kicked in the late drive and prevailed. GOLDEN MYSTERY away alertly, rushed up take early lead, steadily widen margin in the backstretch, continued clear at the top of the lane, challenged by SUCCESSFUL SONG midstretch and weakened slightly before the wire. MY PAL CHRISY stalked the early front runners, steadily gained position two wide heading into far turn, continued three wide in the stretch and lacked late needed kick in the drive. CALLMETHESQUEEZE unhurried in early stages, began to advance position along the inside nearing the far turn and finished evenly in late drive.
