APRIORITY stumbled badly at the start, moved up quickly to chase the pace along the rail, then responded to pressure in the drive and rallied inside ZERO RATE POLICY to be just up at the wire. The latter, set the pace under pressure along the inside, edged away while coming off the rail entering the stretch and continued on with good courage while just failing to last. INDIANO rated off the pace after breaking awkwardly, angled out for the stretch run and was gaining on the top ones at the finish. CAPT. CANDYMAN CAN reserved early, raced four wide around the far turn but didn't do enough late. THE HUNK raced with the pace three wide to the top of the stretch, then tired. IMMORTAL EYES pressed the pace outside ZERO RATE POLICY into the stretch and faltered. NATHAN'S H Q raced three wide and faded.
