Footnotes

COMMODORE BOB raced comfortably well off the pace for the first mile, made steady progress going down the back side for the last time, got in striking distance jumping the third last, rallied through the stretch, jumped the last clear and was able to hold of a charging rival. CLASS CENTURY was well off the pace until three jumps from home, rallied in top turn and closed with a rush and just missed at the wire. DEALER BEWARE set the pace for the first two miles, but failed to sustain bid in the stretch run. AMADOR was allowed to settle early, got in contention three fences from home and was even through the stretch. MATTITUCK INLET raced mid pack, had mild rally in top turn, and then flattened out. SLANEY ROCK (IRE) stalked pace throughout, got to the lead at the head of the stretch, and then weakened. PRIMERO PERU was never far off the lead, made mild bid between calls going down the back side for the last time then flatten out. FREEBOARD was in contention for two miles then tired. HIDDEN TRAIL was close to the pace until the final turn then tired badly. STRATEGIC VISSION was through after a mile and pulled up before the last jump. BETTER THAN EVEN was through after one mile, fell back and pulled up after second last jump. COLONIAL KID was through after a mile fell back and was pulled up with a circuit to go.
