BUBBLE ECONOMY voided early speed, got in contention on the backside for the final time when the leaders were backing up, got the lead in the upper stretch, lost the lead after the last jump then came again to regain the lead just a few lengths from the wire. BON CADDO trailed the field for the first two miles, got in contention 4 jumps from home, rallied in upper stretch, dueled with the winner from the last jump home and just missed. PATRIOT'S PATH was off pace early, rallied in top turn for the last time but could not gain on the leaders. ERIN GO BRAGH (NZ) was close up three fences from home then fell back. J. ALFRED PRUFROCK raced close to the back, rallied down the backside for the final time then weakened. HE'S A CONNIVER assumed command and opened up on the field, led for three miles then fell back and was pulled up before the last jump. RAINBOWS FOR LUCK was in contention and lost his rider at the third last jump. FORT HENRY (IRE) tried to chase the leader and was through after two miles.
