FANTASTIC FOE was well placed in the back of the pack but always within striking distance, rallied in top turn, gained a slight lead going to the second last jump and drew clear from there. SO AMAZING (IRE) was never far from the lead, rallied top turn and ran gamely through the stretch. ONE SEA up close throughout duled in stretch, held on for third. DUBAI SUNDAY (JPN) set pace weakened in stretch. HOPE FOR US ALL close up for two miles then fell back. CLASS CRASH raced in the back jumped poorly and was pulled up before the last jump. POPLAR GROVE made a mild bid on backside between calls and then lost rider third last jump. EAGLE BEAGLE failed to steer in the lower turn leaving the course. DYNAMIC RHYTHM trailed field and was pulled up with a turn to go.
