FOUR SCHOOLS (IRE) took lead after three fences, scraped over the water jump - fence 8, was overtaken briefly on final turn, regained lead over final two fences, and responded courageously when pressed in stretch to prevail. BOW STRADA (GB) rated well, closed with a rush. DUKE OF EARL (IRE) gave a late rally. CUSE was well placed, gave a mild rally on inside path. SWIMMING RIVER stalked the pace, bid on turn to take the lead, then flattened out and faded to fifth. HUMDINGER was never a threat. FABI'S LEGACY was hard held from start, and lacked a response. FANTORINI trailed and was pulled up.
