INCOMPLETE was allowed to settle, rallied, battled with three contenders and emerged clear after final fence holding a length advantage to the wire. G'DAY G'DAY rated nicely, closed well to be in contention at final fence, then was outfinished in the stretch. GUTS FOR GARTERS (IRE) had narrow lead on backstretch, was in contention at the final fence, then was outfinished in the stretch. BUBBLE ECONOMY stalked the pace, rallied, was in contention at the final fence, bobbled the final fence costing some ground, for an overall good effort. AERO was allowed to settle in the rear, slipped and lost action on backstretch. YIN YANG raced up close early, dropped back and was pulled up. VOLER BAR NUIT had sizeable lead early, weakened from the pace and was pulled up.
