THE OTHER ME gave an even effort. BRIMSON moved up on turn into third, then weakened. SHADY VALLEY was never a threat. A FINE STORY (GB) stalked pace till backstretch on final circuit, then tired. PROFOWENS (IRE) was well placed, chased the leader final circuit, stopped on the final turn. PROFESSOR MAXWELL stalked pace from the start, tired going into final turn and dropped back.
