WILMA LEE stalked the pace inside, gained control upper stretch and drew off. L'ABIDJANAISE raced in the middle of the pack, saved ground and had a late rally. QUONOUCHONTAUG, void of speed, rallied between horses and finished well. ROAD TO CASEYS stalked the pace and flattened out. EXPENSIVE COFFEE was well back and improved position in the stretch. ATAWHIRL stalked the pace and tired. SWEET HUNTER was close for a half and flattened out. WESTERN MINT raced evenly and no factor. NAKED CRESCENT was not a threat. FROM THE HEARTLAND was also not a threat. PUNCH AND VOLLEY was outrun. DOWHATYOUWANTTWODO good early speed, faltered.
