SALTY SARGE forwardly placed, moved five wide into the stretch and edged clear under firm handling. JOY FROM PHOENIX saved ground, angled four wide into the stretch and finished well. MARTINI MYST reserved while five wide, entered the stretch four wide and stayed on. RED ROLLS ROYCE settled well, moved five wide into the stretch and lodged a mild bid. UP SUGAR CREEK grabbed the lead, was brushed aside at the stretch and tired. CAT ON A WIRE chased the pace while six wide and posed no threat. HEZA GAMER was outpaced and never a factor. TOTALLY UNREAL stalked the pace and weakened in the stretch. POWERFUL PEPPER never menaced. ATLANTIC RIDGE raced in striking position and faded in the stretch. HIGH NOON MADNESS was awkward at the start and never involved. RUN CHUG RUN showed little.
