Footnotes

BIG BAD MIKE broke readily to dispute the lead inside foes, edged forward to a narrow advantage along the rail racing through the turn, then held sway on a clear margin to the end while being kept to steady pressure. NO PASSAGE, reserved in hand while being guided near to the inside early, saved ground while steadily drawing into striking distance and proved best of the others. RENO RIDGE tracked just off the first flight while caught six wide in the opening stages, advanced to contention racing five deep on the turn, then continued well enough to earn a share while lacking the needed final bid. TOP SERGEANT tracked off the first flight along the inside racing to the bend and continued evenly into the stretch. U STEP ASIDE, close up five wide in the opening quarter, lost some position on the turn, but continued with interest in that path racing into the stretch to pass some tiring foes. LO ME joined the pace four deep between rivals soon after the break and gave way after a half. SPEND WILDLY vied for command three wide between foes racing into the bend and gave way in upper stretch. FESS UP WILLY tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight racing to the turn but lacked any closing response. STAR RATING pressed the pace between foes near the inside racing into the bend but came empty after a half. NOTTOOSCARY broke a step slowly and trailed throughout.
