Footnotes

O'CONNELL'S (BRZ) was settled along the inside in the opening stages, made a steady advance to contention inside foes entering the far turn, swung outside foes entering upper stretch while continuing well and reeled in TENPIN ALLEY under strong handling and some right handed encouragement to prevail in time. The latter secured a forward placing along the inside tracking just off the leaders, moved to wrest command entering the far turn, held sway into upper stretch but couldn't contain the winner. LITTLE FEAT, held up saving ground in the second flight racing to the backstretch, shifted out leaving the far turn to challenge but proved no match for the top pair. JACKS AGAIN was settled outside a rival for a half, angled to the inside on the far turn, gathered some momentum leaving the second bend, switched out in upper stretch and continued to improve position. FAST PROMISES, allowed to settle in the opening stages, was caught five wide while under some pressure to advance racing into the far turn but lacked the needed final response. SIR REDFORD tracked the leaders unhurried near the inside, shifted out nearing the second bend, was caught four wide between foes on the far turn and lacked the needed rally. STRONG STAG was urged to the lead near the inside, went clear after a half but emptied out abruptly once headed entering the far turn. BOSCO RULES, forwardly placed three wide between foes racing into the backstretch, chased the leader for a half and gave way on the far turn. GO BY GOLD tracked the leaders outside a rival in second flight under some reserve but offered no closing bid. QUIET REVOLUTION was urged to terms with the first flight racing four deep into the backstretch but quickly retreated after a half.
