Footnotes

GRATTAN STREET was guided to the rail gaining a tracking position just off the first flight, was caught in close quarters approaching the far turn, shifted outside the pacesetter midway through the second bend to challenge for command, took over nearing midstretch and held sway to the end under firm encouragement. MASSECUITE was held up off just off the first flight racing outside a rival to the backstretch, continued under some reserve when racing in close quarters nearing the far turn, stumbled when clipping heels while steadying off GRATTAN STREET near the five sixteenths marker, split foes nearing upper stretch, shifted out three wide to challenge but couldn't regain terms with the winner. TIO CHENCHO, a bit unruly in the gate before the start, broke outwards, was collected to track along the inside, made steady progress nearing the far turn, shifted out three deep midway through the far turn, altered course to split foes nearer the inside entering upper stretch and continued well enough to gain a share. LOYAL LIGHTFOOT, reserved along the inside in the opening half, saved ground to upper stretch, then switched outside foes in late stages while making some belated progress. FRIENDLY LINDY was urged to the lead along the inside racing to the first turn, dictated the pace a bit off the inside into the far turn, held sway into upper stretch but emptied out once headed by the winner. POOR JOHN angled to the rail in the opening stages to track the pace unhurried behind the second flight into the backstretch but lacked a closing response when called upon on the far turn. C SAGA RYDER, bothered by TIO CHENCHO at the start, was settled off the inside, came around some tiring rivals leaving the second bend, altered course five wide in upper stretch but couldn't seriously menace. FRANK'S CHOICE shifted

outside foes tracking just off the second flight racing to the backstretch but steadily retreated after a half. ROSEMONT SAMMY was hustled to join a rival on the pace, forced the issue racing to the far turn, drifted out on the second bend and gave way early. PROTECTION GAME ducked outwards at the start, was righted to briefly track outside foes to the second bend but was through after a half. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INTO THE INCIDENT ON THE FAR TURN AND THE RIDER OF MASSECUITE LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST THE RIDER OF GRATTAN STREET, ALLEGING INTERFERENCE. THE STEWARDS DISQUALIFIED GRATTAN STREET FOR INTERFERENCE, PLACING HIM SECOND.
