ITCHY TOES, bobbled a bit at the start, was quickly righted to stalk just off and outside the leaders racing to the turn, bid three deep for command entering upper stretch and took over late under firm encouragement. TRIPPLE ZIP was urged to gain terms with a rival on the pace along the inside from the outset, dueled for command, drifted out a bit in upper stretch while resisting challenges from both sides but weakened a bit in late stages while continuing well enough to prevail for the place. SKIRTING DISASTER tracked just off the leaders racing unhurried along the inside in the opening half, bid for command inside foes nearest the rail in upper stretch but was outkicked in the drive. UMMA UMMA, carried out just after start, angled to the inside while regaining a tracking position racing to the bend but came up empty after a half. SUAVE DOTTIE M. ducked outwards at the start impeding a rival, was quickly collected off that foe to track the leaders three wide racing to the turn, then steadily faded from contention. GOLDEN THIEF went up from the break to force the pace outside a rival, was forced wide by that foe entering upper stretch and quickly gave way.
