Footnotes

COME ON MAN, within striking distance outside foes from the outset, moved to challenge the pacesetter racing into the turn, gained a clear advantage entering upper stretch and drew clear late while being kept to firm right handed pressure. NEWS BULLETIN tracked the leaders along the rail in second flight racing into the turn, shifted out nearing midstretch to split foes and proved best of the others. DOCKTOR DEMENTED tracked just off the leaders as part of the second flight between foes, angled three deep nearing upper stretch while being urged to advance but lacked the needed final bid. LOOK WEST, bumped at the start, was righted to track three deep between foes racing just off the second flight into the turn and continued evenly in that path through the stretch. GRUDGE MATCH, urged to the lead along the inside in the opening stages, dueled for command along the rail on the turn and gave way in upper stretch when failing to match the winner. DON CARMELO was a bit outpaced early and never gained contention. BIBB COUNTY, a bit reluctant to load in the starting gate, raced four wide into the turn tracking just off the second flight and steadily faded racing into upper stretch. SUMMER SERVANT broke outwards bumping LOOK WEST at the start, shifted to the inside dropping well off the second flight early and never gained contention. SEARCH NO MORE, fractious in the gate before the start, never seriously menaced. MATT COLE, going erratically between foes while under pressure racing as part of the second flight, steadily faded racing into upper stretch.
