STAN THE TAP MAN, within striking distance four deep in the opening stages, stalked the leaders racing to the turn, moved to challenge three deep with a steady advance nearing upper stretch, took over leaving the furlong marker and drove clear under firm encouragement. THIEF, shuffled back out of tight quarters at the start, steadily gained position near the inside on the bend, shifted five wide racing into upper stretch and continued with interest to secure

place honors. COLORADO TRAIL broke inwards, tracked off the second flight off the inside racing into the turn and continued willingly between foes to late stages to prevail for a share. STITCHNTWINE settled outside foes out of striking distance early, was fanned six wide racing into upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. ENNIS was hustled to the lead along the rail, set the pace to upper stretch and gave way once headed nearing the furlong marker. GRATTAN STREET tracked off the second flight along the inside racing into the turn and continued evenly into the stretch. UNEXPECTED VALOR tracked just off the leaders along the inside as part of the second flight racing into the turn but steadily faded leaving midstretch. NOLAN'S TERRITORY settled three deep between foes racing well off the second flight early but never gained striking distance. ALABAMA CLAY was urged to force the pace outside a rival racing into the bend, dueled for command on the bend and gave way entering upper stretch. NO LIP tracked off the second flight between foes racing into the bend but offered no rally. RIVERSIDE RASCAL was never a factor. CLOUD CASTLE trailed throughout.
