CHAMPAGNE TONY broke slowly, steadily drew into contention while angling to the inside racing into the turn, continued with a steady advance along the rail to challenge inside the pacesetter nearing midstretch and edged clear late under firm right handed encouragement. PHISH FAN sprinted clear of the field in the opening stages, set the pace just off the rail racing into the turn, briefly resisted the winner's challenge nearing midstretch but proved only second best. LA PINATA, within striking distance three deep in the opening stages, chased the pacesetter between foes in that path to upper stretch and finished evenly late. I'M OLD SCHOOL, forwardly placed four deep stalking just off the leaders in the opening stages, continued in that path through the turn to upper stretch while continuing with a steady bid but lacked the needed final response. FLYBY DUBAI settled into stride along the inside in the opening stages and never mounted a serious challenge. PULA PULA settled into stride racing well off the inside in the opening quarter, continued six wide into upper stretch and proved no threat.
