**Footnotes**

SHERRY'S TIGER, forwardly placed along the inside racing into the first turn, shifted three wide entering the backstretch, commenced a steady advance in that path entering the far turn, drew on even terms with MOONLIT ROAD leaving midstretch and just edged that foe in a long drive. The latter, urged to a forward placing between foes racing into the first turn, relinquished the lead entering the backstretch, tracked the pacesetter to the second bend while shifting outside that foe, moved to wrest command leaving the far turn, gained a narrow advantage midstretch and just failed to fend off the winner. EAST COASTER, allowed to settle outside foes in the opening half, continued evenly racing four wide into upper stretch to gain a share in the closing stages. TARVA tracked just off the first flight saving ground into the backstretch, continued along the inside to upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. SHINY STAR was urged to the fore three wide in the opening stages, moved clear entering the backstretch while angling in to the rail, set the pace into the far turn and gave way leaving midstretch. ARRESTED BY DUFFY, unhurried tracking the leaders in the last flight racing to the first turn, was steadied when clipping heels with DUBIOUS entering the first turn and never gained contention thereafter. SIN BIN was a brief factor tracking the leaders outside a rival in the second flight racing to the backstretch but retreated from contention after a half. DUBIOUS, unhurried near the inside in the opening stages, shifted a bit off the rail on the first turn while tracking off the second flight, continued three deep into the backstretch and steadily faded from contention on the far turn.
