**Footnotes**

SIGNSEALNDELIVER, unhurried outside foes in the second flight racing just out of striking distance, was urged to advance while shifting four wide racing into upper stretch and produced a steady late response to wrest command in time under firm right handed encouragement. KIND REGARDS broke readily to gain a narrow advantage a bit off the inside, dictated the pace on a narrow margin while between foes racing into the turn, edged forward to a clear margin nearing midstretch, drifted out making some contact with CAPT. BULLET BOB in late stages but proved only second best when confronted by the winner. CAPT. BULLET BOB, prominent four wide in the opening stages, was urged to force the issue three deep racing into the bend, continued to dispute the issue between the top pair to late stages while exchanging some contact late but was just unfinished. TAPTOWNE, bumped at the start, was quickly righted to track just off the first flight between foes racing to the bend, angled to the inside to bid inside the leaders entering upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. MISFIRED swerved out at the start while breaking a bit awkwardly, was guided to the inside settling in late, swung out five wide racing into upper stretch, gained some position late but made no real impression. NO GOOD DEED settled off the second flight while angling to the inside, saved ground to upper stretch but lacked a rally. HAPMAN, urged along three deep between foes while briefly contesting the lead, dropped out nearing upper stretch. ALL TANKED UP broke outwards bumping TAPTOWNE, was urged to press the pace racing nearest the rail into the bend but was spent early.
