Footnotes

MISSJEANLOUISE moved readily to the fore along the rail just after the start, dictated the pace on her own courage racing into the turn, moved clear when given her cue in upper stretch and widened her advantage in a ridden out effort. GAMBLER FIVE was urged to gain terms with the pacesetter from between foes in the opening furlong, pressed the pace between foes into upper stretch, couldn't match the winner in the final three sixteenths of a mile but proved best of the others. DE LICA tracked just off the leaders three deep in the opening stages, moved to challenge in that path after a half but gave way nearing midstretch. SHEESA GUSKA DEVIL broke in the air, was guided to the rail to track just off the leaders racing to the bend but steadily faded nearing upper stretch.
