SHES GOT TO RUN was urged to secure a contending position between foes in the second flight in the opening quarter, continued between foes awaiting an opening nearing upper stretch, altered course avoiding tight quarters to challenge three deep nearing the furlong marker and responded with a solid late response to wrest command and draw clear under firm handling. CITYRAP tracked the leaders four wide in the second flight racing to the turn, made a steady advance in that path to challenge after a half, gained brief command near midstretch but proved no match when confronted by the winner. LOCK N LOLA angled inwards gaining a forward placing, tracked the pacesetter three deep in the second flight, moved to challenge in that path racing through the turn while drifting inwards brushing the eventual winner nearing the quarter mile marker, gained a brief advantage racing into upper stretch but was outfinished by the top pair. TEXAS AGGIE, bumped at the start, made steady progress along the inside to regain contention entering the bend, awaited an opening between foes racing through the turn, shifted out five wide near the quarter mile marker to challenge but flattened out in upper stretch. J S P PALS FOREVER was guided to the rail tracking the leader in second flight in the opening stages, shifted out of close quarters entering upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. TRAC N JAM broke slowly, settled into stride and passed inside some tiring rivals racing through the stretch. SILVER CRUSH,

reserved off the pace racing off the inside, never mounted a serious challenge. CHALLENGE ME was steadied a bit while breaking outwards, was righted to track off the second flight five wide racing to the turn, was fanned six wide in upper stretch and offered no rally. AVANTIBDANCING broke inwards bumping TEXAS AGGIE, was settled into stride and never menaced thereafter. WAR VICTORY tracked off the second flight between foes in the opening stages but retreated from contention early. FACEY'S SPIRIT was hustled to the lead, angled to the rail once clear, dueled for command on the turn and gave way in upper stretch. OUR RACHEL trailed.
