**Footnotes**

JUMP TO START went up to dictate the pace between foes on a narrow margin racing just off the inside to the backstretch, continued to dictate terms while shifting to the inside entering upper stretch, then turned back several challengers in late stages to narrowly prevail under firm right handed encouragement. SWEETEST RHYTHM, caught four wide tracking off the second flight racing to the backstretch, moved to challenge in that path leaving the far turn, drifted out in late stretch while disputing the issue between foes and just lost the nod. ELECTRIC ALPHABET, forwardly placed three deep under light rating racing to the backstretch, moved to press the issue just outside the eventual winner racing into upper stretch and was just outfinished. HUNGRY WILDCAT, reserved along the inside in the opening stages, swung out five wide racing into upper stretch, came around a drifting rival in late stages but continued willingly to the end to close the gap. SHIP'S CABIN, held up off the second flight in the opening stages, moved to bid between foes on the far turn to upper stretch but had no final kick. NO SONG N DANCE settled into stride off the inside, was caught five wide racing through the far turn but made some mild progress to late stages. JOHNNY CADILLAC was a brief factor between foes tracking the leader but retreated early. TSUNAMI KING, close up along the rail stalking the pacesetter in the opening half, steadily retreated racing through the far turn.
