Footnotes

CUB'S THUNDER tracked the pace outside foes as part of the second flight racing to the bend, shifted out five wide entering upper stretch while moving to striking distance, took over leaving the furlong marker and held GAMBLER FIVE safe to the end under firm handling. The latter broke slowly, settled into stride, gathered momentum while switching out six wide racing into upper stretch and was going well late to close the gap. REMEMBERMEALWAYS tracked just off the first flight while steadily angling to the inside, bid for command along the rail nearing upper stretch to gain the advantage between calls but flattened out late. POINT YOUR FINGER tracked off the second flight racing into the bend, steadily drew into contention nearing upper stretch, altered course six wide racing through upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. MYSTERY RIDGE tracked off the second flight along the inside early, advanced to striking distance along the rail entering upper stretch, was caught in tight quarters nearing the furlong marker and had no late response. TURTLE PIE, close up four wide in the opening stages, moved to challenge in that path racing to the stretch, drifted in nearing the furlong marker impeding DOROTHY Y and TACTICS RAP and lacked the needed final response. DUBIOUS settled out of striking distance near the inside racing to the turn and never seriously menaced. TACTICS RAP was urged to the fore racing a bit off the inside, set the pace into the turn, gave way entering upper stretch, then was steadied when bumped and caught in close quarters nearing the furlong marker. DOROTHY Y was urged to secure terms with rivals on the pace while between foes racing to the bend, gave way entering upper stretch, then was shuffled in close quarters approaching the furlong marker. SANTO RIO was settled into stride off the inside and never menaced. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN BUT ELECTED TO TAKE NO ACTION.
