ON THE SNEAK forced out a bit at the start, was hustled between foes to secure the lead in the opening furlong, turned back a challenge to go well clear in upper stretch and held sway to the end under steady prompting. KONA KID ducked outwards at the start, was righted to stalk just off the leaders along the inside racing to the bend, shifted out to split foes leaving the quarter mile marker and proved best of the others while never menacing the winner. ACHIEVABLE, off a step slowly, then caught in tight quarters at the start, was settled along the inside, saved ground to upper stretch and made some mild progress to improve his placing late. SWEEP AWAY was settled between foes in the opening quarter, angled five wide entering upper stretch but had little impact. DAKOTA METT chased the pacesetter four wide on the backstretch, angled inwards while closing the gap on that rival after a half, drifted out in upper stretch and quickly gave way. CLASSIC RECITAL, prominent between foes from the outset, stalked just off the leaders outside a rival racing into the bend, was steadied momentarily off KONA KID approaching upper stretch but came up empty when called upon to advance. JIMMIE THE JET, reserved outside foes in early stages, never mounted a serious challenge. FOLLOWING THE RACE, THE TRAINER OF CLASSIC RECITAL LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST THE RIDER OF KONA KID, WHICH WAS DISALLOWED.
