DUKETTE'S FLAME broke sharply was urged along inside foes disputing the pace racing into the bend, gained a narrow advantage after a half while shifting a bit off the inside and continued with a solid late response to hold safe the challenge of SECOND HAND ROSY to the end under firm right handed encouragement. The latter, brushed just after the start, was guided to the inside early tracking just off the first flight racing into the bend, came through inside the pacesetter to challenge that foe racing into upper stretch but couldn't gain even terms with that foe. SECRET VIOLET, reserved a bit off the inside in the opening stages, angled to the inside racing into the turn while gaining some position racing through the bend, shifted out four wide in upper stretch and continued evenly in the late stages while earning a share. QUEEN OF HEAT, prominent three deep in the opening stages, pressed the pacesetter racing into the turn, couldn't match that foe after a half and steadily faded racing through the stretch. DASH AWAY broke slowly and never gained contention. ROSIE'S WILD TALE, forwardly placed between foes briefly prompting the pace, was spent early. PUSHIN UP DAISY took a few awkward steps just after the start shifting inwards brushing SECOND HAND ROSY, shifted outside foes to race five wide into the turn while offering some brief pursuit but quickly retreated.
