BEAUCOUP GOLD, reserved in last while being guided to the inside in the opening quarter, steadily gathered momentum along the inside nearing upper

stretch, shifted out seven wide racing into upper stretch and produced a stout rally to wrest command and kick clear in time under firm handling. TIGER MIKE broke sharply, disputed the pace just off the rail racing into the bend, continued to skirmish for command past the furlong marker, couldn't contain the winner's bid but prevailed for second. MACHO JOE tracked just off the first flight along the rail under light rating racing into the turn, came through close quarters to challenge inside the leaders nearing midstretch but was just outkicked. CALL TO GLORY joined the pace outside a rival from the break, pressed the issue three deep between foes to upper stretch but weakened in late stages. LITTLEBROWNROAD, a bit slow into stride, tracked the leaders out of striking distance racing to the turn, shifted out five wide entering upper stretch but continued with interest in an effort to improve position. EXOTIC WILDCAT, a bit slow into stride, saved ground on the turn, gained some position inside foes racing into the stretch and finished evenly in late stages. SLEW CITY STORM settled outside foes in the last flight early, angled seven wide racing into upper stretch but proved no threat. GHETTO CAT was settled outside foes racing to the turn, was fanned nine wide racing into upper stretch and proved no factor. ONE FOR BISCUIT, caught five deep between foes while under pressure to maintain striking position racing into the turn, steadily retreated after a half. DADDYSPENTDAMONEY, caught six wide while under prompting to pursue the leaders while within striking distance early, emptied out racing into upper stretch. WILD PARTY vied four deep between foes racing into the turn and emptied out after a half. LONGER VERSION, held up just off the first flight between foes in the opening stages, shifted out eight wide racing into upper stretch and steadily faded.
