Footnotes

QUALITY DIPLOMAT, forced outwards a bit at the start by IZZY GOLDEN while shifting into the path of PULGARcito, was quickly righted then hustled to the lead while angling to the rail in the opening furlong, dictated terms on a clear margin through the bend and held TANK'S LETTER safe through the final quarter under firm handling. The latter was urged to secure a forward placing while shifting inwards in the opening stages, chased the pacesetter into upper stretch while closing the gap on that foe but proved only second best. DOONEY ROCK, shuffled a bit in tight quarters at the start, settled a bit off the inside racing to the turn, angled out five wide entering upper stretch and found his best stride late to close the gap while earning a share. BIGSURPRISEMISTER tracked the pace inside foes in the second flight racing into the bend, shifted out nearing upper stretch while being roused to advance but lacked the needed final response. CRYPTO GULCH tracked off the second flight in the opening stages, raced five wide into the turn but continued with some mile interest to improve position. IZZY GOLDEN swerved out at the start momentarily impeding several foes, was righted to track off the second flight racing to the turn but offered no rally. KHUKURI tracked off the second flight along the inside in the opening stages but never mounted a serious threat. PULGARcito, pinched back at the start, trailed the field to the stretch. ALABAMA CLAY was a brief factor between foes in the second flight but emptied out after a half.
