Footnotes

GRANDPA GIBBY, never far back, stalked just off the pacesetter three deep under light rating racing to the backstretch, moved to press the issue midway through the far turn, dueled to midstretch and edged clear late under steady pressure and a few right handed taps. CATCH THE TRAIN sped to the fore in the opening stages, dictated the pace between foes on a narrow margin while between foes racing into the far turn, resisted the winner's challenge past midstretch but came up only second best. IDEAL ALLUVIAL gained terms with the leaders along the rail while attending the pace under rating racing into the backstretch, was eased off those foes to track off the first flight racing into the far turn and weakened when failing to match the top pair late. GO POSSE GO, allowed to settle off the inside racing to the backstretch, never gained contention. BECKNERVILLE BOUND hopped at the start, recovered quickly to track just off the first flight racing to the backstretch but steadily faded racing into upper stretch.
