Footnotes

DUSTINCASE was rated just out of striking position outside the first flight in the opening stages, made steady progress four wide on the bend to challenge in that path entering upper stretch, took over leaving the furlong marker and drew clear under firm encouragement. ZAVATA'S GOLD hopped a bit at the start, settled well off the field, shifted out racing into the bend, angled five wide racing into upper stretch and continued with a steady late response to wrest place honors late. GEORGIE MY BOY broke sharply, stalked just off the pacesetter racing into the bend, pressed the issue three deep between foes nearing upper stretch but flattened out leaving the furlong marker when failing to fend off the winner, then lost second in late stages. SANDIA CREST, a bit reluctant to load, was settled off the second flight racing off the inside into the turn, then made an effort to improve position three deep between foes in late stages. TENS WILD settled well off the leaders along the inside racing into the turn but never gained contention. SMALL TOWN EMPEROR was hustled to secure the lead from between foes soon after the break, set the pace for a half and gave way nearing midstretch. GRACIES BRUDDER chased the pacesetter along the rail into the bend but steadily retreated nearing upper stretch.
