Footnotes

REBUTTABLE broke inwards making some contact with KEY TO WINNING, was urged to the lead from between foes, dictated the pace on a narrow margin just off the inside racing into the turn, shook clear entering upper stretch and held safe the late challenge of MOONBLAST under pressure. The latter settled outside foes from just out of striking distance racing to the bend, advanced on the leader racing five wide into upper stretch and made a steady effort to close the gap. TOUGH ESCAPE broke inwards, was urged along in pursuit of the pacesetter racing three deep between foes into the turn to upper stretch but finished evenly in late stages. DESERT RATTLER broke out bumping KEY TO WINNING, was righted to chase the pacesetter along the inside while racing in close quarters, checked off foes leaving the the seven sixteenth marker and never regained contention. TWOSHADESOFBROWN, held up out of tight quarters at the start, raced wide into the stretch while never mounting a serious challenge. KEY TO WINNING, bumped from both sides at the start, vied briefly between foes despite his rider losing his irons, shifted to the inside nearing the turn and steadily faded from contention entering upper stretch. TAKE SOME ADVICE vied for command four wide racing into the turn and gave way entering upper stretch. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED A GENERAL INQUIRY INTO THE RUN THROUGH THE BACKSTRETCH BUT NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
